MARCHING BAND FAQ

What is Marching Band?

 Marching Band is an activity that combines music and movement to create performances that are both entertaining and educational. The Mighty Marching Chargers is recognized as one of the most popular and beloved student activities in the CHS community.

Who can participate in Marching Band?

• Any student signed up for a band class at CHS is eligible to participate. Students not enrolled in a band class have the opportunity to participate as a member of the Color Guard only.

Is Marching Band all year?

• No. Marching Band begins a few weeks before school starts with our summer camps. The season usually ends in early November, typically around the end of the 1st quarter.

When does Marching Band Camp start?

- The first day of marching band camp varies for certain instruments/sections. Please see the included calendar for further information.
- Our Marching Band camp dates (July 31-Aug. 18) serve as the backbone of our season and our students' success. It is important for families to coordinate summer travel and vacation plans outside of these dates. Please contact us directly with any questions about this.

Where does the Marching Band perform?

 We typically perform at all Varsity home football games, two away games, and 4-5 marching band competitions each season. Varsity football games usually occur on Friday nights and our competition performances begin in late September and occur on Saturdays.

Does Marching Band practice during the school day?

- No, once school begins the marching band practices after school 3 days a week. Below are the practice days for each section of the band:
 - ✓ Percussion and Color Guard Monday, Wednesday, Thursday
 - √ Woodwinds and Brass Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday
